There is neither sorcery nor divination against me; it is said of me, "Oh, what God has done" (23:23)

The Lord makes me a thousand times more and blesses me (1:11)

I do not take a bribe (16:19)

God is my inheritance (18:2)

God turns curses against me into blessings because He loves me (23:5)

I shall not oppress a hired servant who is needy and poor (24:14)

I am blessed in the city and blessed in the country; blessed is the fruit of my body, the produce of my ground and the increase of my herds; blessed is my basket and kneading bowl; blessed am I when I come in and blessed am I when I go out. The Lord commands a blessing in my storehouses and in all to which I set my hand and He blesses me in this land (28:3-6,8)

The Lord grants me plenty of goods in the fruit of my body, in the increase of my livestock, and in the produce of my ground, He opens to me His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to my land in its season, and to bless all the work of my hand, I lend to many nations but do not borrow, He makes me the head and not the tail, I am above only and not beneath (28:11-13)

The Lord rejoices over me to do me good and to multiply me (28:63)

The Lord prospers me and multiplies me more than my fathers (30:5)

He blesses my substance and accepts the work of my hands. Blessed of the Lord is my land with the precious things of heaven, with the dew, and the deep lying beneath, with the precious fruits of the sun, with the precious produce of the months, with the best things of the ancient mountains, with the precious things of the everlasting hills, with the precious things of the earth and its fullness, and the favor of Him who dwelt in the bush; the blessing is on my head and crown. I partake of the abundance of the seas and of treasures hidden in the sand; I am satisfied with favor and are full of the blessing of the Lord; I am most blessed, my brethren favor me (33:11,13-16,19,23,24)

Joshua

Every place that the sole of my foot treads, God has given me (1:3)

God's Word does not depart from my mouth, but I meditate upon it day and night to observe it. Therefore I have made my way prosperous and I have good success (1:8)

I come home with many riches, with much livestock, with silver, with gold, with bronze, and with iron, and with much clothing (22:8)

God gives me land for which I did not labor, and cities which I did not build; I eat of the vineyards and olive groves which I did not plant (24:13)

Ruth

I am a man of great wealth (2:1)

The Lord repays me for my work, and a full reward is given by Him under whose wings I have come for refuge (2:12)

First Samuel

God makes me rich; He sets me among princes and makes me inherit the throne of glory (2:7, 8)

I am increasing in favor with both God and men (2:26)

I am very rich and I live in prosperity (25:2, 6)

I am blessed; I shall do great things and shall also still prevail (26:25)

Second Samuel

The Lord has blessed me and my entire household (6:11)

The Lord is with me wherever I go and He makes my name great like the name of the great men who are on the earth (7:9)

It has pleased the Lord to bless my house (7:29)

I eat continually at the king's table (9:13)

I am a very rich man (19:32)

The Lord rewards me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands He has recompensed me (22:21)

First Kings

I keep the Word of God and so I prosper in all I do and wherever I turn (2:3)

The Lord gives me both riches and honor (3:13)

I am full of wisdom and understanding and skill in working (7:14)

I surpass all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom (10:23)

My bin of flour shall not be used up, nor shall the jar of oil run dry, according to the Word of the Lord (17:16)

Second Kings

The Lord is with me and I prosper wherever I go (18:7)

I shall eat this year such as grows of itself, and in the second year what springs from the same; also in the third year I shall sow and reap, plant vineyards and eat the fruit of them (19:29)

First Chronicles

I am more honorable than all my brothers; the Lord blesses me and enlarges my territory (4:9,10)

God blesses my house and all that I have (13:14)

The Lord is with me and I prosper and I build His house as He said to me (22:11)

From all that the Lord gives me, I prepare an abundance to build a house for His holy Name. God tests the heart and has pleasure in uprightness, so in the uprightness of my heart I willingly offer toward building His house (29:16,17)

Second Chronicles

God gives me riches and wealth and honor, such as none of those who were before me (1:12)

I am strong and will not let my hands become weak, for my work shall be rewarded of God (15:7)

I believe in the Lord my God, so I am established; I believe His prophets, and therefore I prosper (20:20)

I am like Zechariah, having understanding in visions; and as long as I seek the Lord, He will make me prosper (26:5)

Ezra

Whatever seems good to me to do with the silver and gold, I do it according to the will of my God (7:18)

We humble ourselves before my God, to seek from Him the right way for us and our little ones and all our possessions (8:21)

Nehemiah

The God of heaven prospers me (2:20)

God remembers me for good according to all that I have done for His people (5:19)

The Lord sustains me in the wilderness and I lack nothing; my clothes do not wear out and my feet do not swell (9:21)

I take strong cities and a rich land, and possess houses full of all goods, cisterns already dug, vineyards, olive groves, and fruit trees in abundance. So I eat and are filled and grow fat, and delight myself in God's goodness (9:25)

God turns every curse against me into a blessing (13:2)

Esther

I obtain favor in the sight of all who see me (2:15)

The king Jesus loves me more than others, and I obtain grace and favor in his sight more than all the rest (2:17)

Job

In terms of wealth, I am the greatest of all (1:3)

God has made a hedge around me, around my household, and around all that I have on every side. He has blessed the work of my hands, and my possessions have increased in the land (1:10)

In famine God redeems me from death, and in war from the power of the sword. He hides me from the scourge of the tongue, and I am not afraid of destruction when it comes. I laugh at destruction and famine, and am not afraid of the beasts of the earth. I have a covenant with the stones of the field and the beasts of the field are at peace with me. My tent is in peace; I visit my dwelling and find nothing amiss (5:20-24)

God awakes for me and prospers my rightful dwelling place. Though my beginning was small, yet my latter end will increase abundantly (8:6, 7)

God has granted me life and favor, and His care has preserved my spirit (10:12)

I acquaint myself with God, and am at peace with Him; therefore good comes to me (22:21)

The Almighty is my gold and my precious silver (22:25)

Though the wicked heaps up silver like dust, and piles up clothing like clay – he may pile it up, but I the just will wear it, and I the innocent will divide the silver (27:16,17)

I deliver the poor who cry out, the fatherless and the one who has no helper. The blessing of a perishing man comes upon me, and I cause the widow's heart to sing for joy (29:12,13)

I do not keep the poor from their desire or cause the eyes of the widow to fail or eat the morsel by myself, so that the fatherless cannot eat of it (but I rear him as a father and I guide the widow); if I see anyone perish for lack of clothing, or any poor man without covering, I warm him with the fleece of my sheep (31:16-20)

Since I obey and serve God, I spend my days in prosperity, and my years in pleasures (36:11)

God gives me food in abundance (36:31)

God restores my losses and gives me twice as much as I had before; He blesses my latter more than my beginning (42:10,12)

Psalms

My delight is in the Word of the Lord and in His Word I meditate day and night; I am like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in season, whose leaf shall not wither; whatever I do prospers (1:2,3)

I am God's son, He begat me; He gives the nations for my inheritance, and the ends of the earth for my possession (2:7,8)

I am blessed because I have put my trust in God (2:12)

God's blessing is upon me (3:8)

The Lord blesses me the righteous and surrounds me with favor as with a shield (5:12)

The Lord is mindful of me and He visits me; He has crowned me with glory and honor; He has made me have dominion over the works of His hands and put all things under my feet (8:4-6)

I do not put out money at usury nor take a bribe against the innocent. Therefore I shall never be moved (15:5)

The Lord is the portion of my inheritance and my cup; He maintains my lot; the lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; yes, I have a good inheritance (16:5,6)

Poverty and shame will not come to me because I do not disdain instruction; I regard a rebuke and so I am honored (13:18)

I leave an inheritance to my children's children, because I am a good man (13:22)

I eat to the satisfying of my soul because I am righteous (13:25)

I am a good man; I am satisfied from above (14:14)

In all my labor I profit (14:23)

I am wise; my crown is my riches (14:24)

The king's favor is toward me a wise servant (14:35)

In my house there is much treasure, because I am righteous (15:6)

My present is my precious stone; wherever I turn I prosper (17:8)

My stomach is satisfied from the fruit of my mouth; by the produce of my lips I shall be filled (18:20)

Many entreat my favor, and I am one who gives gifts (19:6)

My children will inherit houses and riches (19:14)

I lend to God by having pity on the poor, the Lord shall pay me back (19:17)

I am the righteous man who walks in integrity; my children are blessed after me (20:7)

I do not love sleep lest I come to poverty; I open my eyes and am satisfied with bread (20:13)

I am diligent; my plans lead to plenty (21:5)

I am the righteous who gives and does not spare (21:26)

By my humility and the fear of the Lord are my riches and honor and life (22:4)

The rich rule over the poor and a borrower is servant to the lender. Therefore being rich I shall not lord it over the poor (22:7)

I have a generous eye; I shall be blessed for I give of my bread to the poor (22:9)

I excel in my work, I therefore stand before kings and not before unknown men (22:29)

Through wisdom my house is built, and by understanding it is established; by knowledge the rooms are filled with all precious and pleasant riches (24:3,4)

Those who increase possessions by usury and extortion gather it for me who has pity on the poor (28:8)

I abound with blessings because I am a faithful man (28:20)

I give to the poor; therefore I do not lack (28:27)

My wife is virtuous; her worth is far above rubies. My heart safely trusts her, so I have no lack of gain. She does me good and not evil all the days of her life. She seeks wool and flax and

willingly works with her hands. She is like the merchant ships; she brings her food from afar. She also rises while it is yet night, and provides food for her maidservants. She considers a field and buys it; from her profits she plants a vineyard. She girds herself with strength, and strengthens her arms. She perceives that her merchandise is good, and her lamp does not go out by night. She stretches out her hands to the distaff, and her hand holds the spindle. She extends her hand to the poor, yes; she reaches out her hands to the needy. She is not afraid of snow for her household, for all her household is clothed with scarlet. She makes tapestry for herself; her clothing is fine linen and purple. I am known in the gates, when I sit down among the elders of the land. She makes linen garments and sells them, and supplies sashes for the merchants. Strength and honor are her clothing; she shall rejoice in time to come (31:10-25)

Ecclesiastes

I make my works great, I build houses and plant vineyards; I make gardens and orchards, and I plant all kinds of fruit trees in them; I make water pools from which to water the growing trees of the grove; I acquire male and female servants; I have greater possessions of herds and flocks than all who were before me; I gather silver and gold and the special treasures of kings; I acquire male and female worshippers and musical instruments of all kinds. So I become great and excel more than all who were before me (2:4-9)

My heart rejoices in all my labor and this is my reward (2:10)

My labor is with wisdom, knowledge and skill (2:21)

The sinner's work is to gather and collect that he may give to me who is good before God (2:26)

God has made everything beautiful for me in its time (3:11)

I rejoice and do good; I eat and drink and enjoy the good of all my labor – this is the gift of God (3:12,13)

I rejoice in my own works for that is my heritage (3:22)

God gives me riches and wealth and power to eat of it, to receive my heritage and rejoice in my labor – this is God's gift to me (5:19)

God gives me riches and wealth and honor so that I lack nothing for myself of all I desire (6:2)

I eat my bread with joy and drink with a merry heart; for God has already accepted my works (9:7)

Whatever my hand finds to do I do it with all my might (9:10)

I cast my bread upon the waters, for I will find it after many days; I give a serving to seven, and also to eight, for I do not know what evil will be on the earth; in the morning I sow my seed, in

the evening I do not withhold my hand – for I do not know which will prosper, either this or that or whether both alike will be good (11:1-2, 6)

The Song of Solomon

Jesus is the rose of Sharon and the lily of the valleys; I sit down in His shade with great delight, and His fruit is sweet to my taste; He brings me to the banqueting house, and His banner over me is love (2:1,3,4)

I am fed among the lilies (2:16)

Isaiah

I am willing and obedient, so I eat the good of the land (1:19)

It shall be well with me, for I shall eat the fruit of my doings (3:10)

God gives rain for my seed with which I sow the ground, and bread of the increase of the earth; it will be fat and plentiful (30:23)

I am a generous man who devises generous things, and by my generosity I shall stand (32:8)

I shall dwell in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places (32:18)

I am blessed because I sow beside all waters (32:20)

I despise the gain of oppressions and refuse bribes. Therefore bread is given to me and my water is sure (33:15,16)

God gives me the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret places (45:3)

The Lord has called me and brought me, and my way shall prosper (48:15)

The Lord my God teaches me to profit, and leads me by the way I should go. I heed His commandments; therefore my peace is like a river and my righteousness like the waves of the sea (48:17,18)

I feed along the roads, and my pastures are on all the desolate heights. I shall neither hunger nor thirst, neither heat nor sun shall strike me; for He who has mercy on me leads me, even by the springs of water and He guides me (49:9,10)

I look to Abraham my father, and to Sarah: For God called him alone, and blessed him and increased him. The Lord comforts me, He comforts all my waste places; He makes me like Eden, like the garden of the Lord; joy and gladness are found in me, thanksgiving and the voice of melody (51:2,3)

I enlarge the place of my tent, and stretch out the curtains of my dwellings; I do not spare, I lengthen my cords and strengthen my stakes; for I shall expand to the left and to the right, and my descendants will inherit the nations and make the desolate cities inhabited (54:2,3)

I listen carefully to God, and eat what is good, and my soul delights itself in abundance (55:2)

I put my trust in the Lord and so possess the land and inherit His holy mountain (57:13)

I share my bread with the hungry and bring to my house the poor who are cast out; when I see the naked I cover him. I extend my soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul. The Lord guides me continually, and satisfies my soul in the drought. I am like a watered garden, and like a spring of water whose waters do not fail (58:7,10,11)

I delight myself in the Lord and He causes me to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feeds me with the heritage of Jacob (58:14)

I see and am radiant and my heart swells with joy – because the abundance of the sea is turned to me and the wealth of the Gentiles comes to me. The multitude of camels covers my land, the dromedaries of Midian and Ephah; all those from Sheba come; they bring gold and incense and they proclaim the praises of the Lord. All the flocks of Kedar are gathered together to me, the rams of Nebaioth minister to me and I glorify the house of God's glory. My sons are brought from afar, their silver and gold with them, to the Name of the Lord my God, and to the Holy One of Israel, because He has glorified me. The sons of foreigners build my walls and their kings minister to me. My gates are open continually; they are not shut day or night that men may bring to me the wealth of the Gentiles and their kings in procession. The glory of Lebanon comes to me, the cypress, the pine, and the box tree together, to beautify the place of God's sanctuary; God makes the place of His feet glorious. Whereas I have been forsaken and hated so that no one went through me, God makes me an eternal excellence, a joy of many generations. I drink the milk of the Gentiles, and milk the breast of kings. Instead of bronze God brings me gold, instead of iron He brings me silver, instead of wood, bronze, and instead of stones, iron (60:5-7, 9-11, 13, 15-17)

I rebuild the old ruins; I raise up the former desolations, and repair the ruined cities, the desolations of many generations. Strangers stand and feed my flocks, and the sons of the foreigners are my plowmen and vinedressers. But I am named the priest of the Lord, and they call me the servant of God. I eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory I boast. Instead of shame I have double honor, and instead of confusion I rejoice in my portion. Therefore in my land I possess double; everlasting joy is mine (61:4 -7)

I God's servant eats, drinks, rejoices, and sings for joy of heart (65:13,14)

I build houses and inhabit them, I plant vineyards and eat their fruit; as the days of a tree, so shall be my days. I shall long enjoy the work of my hands. I shall not labor in vain, nor bring forth children for trouble; for my children are descendants of the blessed of the Lord and their offspring with them (65:21-23)

I rejoice with Jerusalem, and am glad with her for I love her; I rejoice for joy for her; therefore I feed and am satisfied with the consolation of her bosom and I drink deeply and am delighted with the abundance of her glory (66:10,11)

God extends peace to me like a river, and the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream (66:12)

Jeremiah

God has brought me into a bountiful country, to eat its fruit and its goodness (2:7)

I do not glory in my wisdom, might and riches; but I glory that I understand and know God (9:24)

Blessed am I who trusts in the Lord, and whose hope is the Lord. For I am like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when trouble comes; for my leaf will be green, and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit (17:7,8)

God visits me and performs His good Word toward me. For He knows the thoughts He thinks toward me, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give me a future and a hope (29:10,11)

The Lord has redeemed me and ransomed me from the evil one. Therefore I sing in the height of Zion, streaming to the goodness of the Lord – for wheat and new wine and oil, for the young of the flock and herd; my soul is like a well-watered garden and I shall sorrow no more at all. God turns my mourning to joy and comforts me, and makes me rejoice rather than sorrow. He satiates my soul with abundance, and I am satisfied with goodness (31:11-14)

God has made an everlasting covenant with me, that He will not turn away from doing me good; He rejoices over me to do me good (32:40,41)

I am to God a name of joy, a praise, and an honor before all nations of the earth, who hear all the good that God does to me; they fear and tremble for all the goodness and all the prosperity that God provides for me (33:9)

The Lord performs the good things which He has promised to me (33:14)

Ezekiel

God makes me thrive like a plant in the field; and I grow and mature, and become very beautiful. My breasts form, my hair grows. He spreads His wing over me and covers my nakedness. He swore an oath to me and entered into a covenant with me, and I became His. He washes me in water; yes, He thoroughly washes me and anoints me with oil. He clothes me in embroidered cloth and gives me sandals of badger skin; He clothes me with fine linen and covers me with silk. He adorns me with ornaments, puts bracelets on my wrists, and a chain on my neck. He puts a jewel on my nose, earring in my ears, and a beautiful crown on my head.

Thus I am adorned with gold and silver, and my clothing is of fine linen, silk, and embroidered cloth. I eat pastry of fine flour, honey, and oil. I am exceedingly beautiful, and succeed to royalty. My fame goes out among the nations because of my beauty, for it is perfect through my splendor which God bestows on me (16:7-14)

I dwell safely, I build houses, and plant vineyards; yes, I dwell securely (28:26)

God makes me and all the places around me a blessing; He causes showers to come down in their season; there are showers of blessing. The trees of the field yield their fruit, and the earth yields her increase. God raises up for me a garden of renown, and I am no longer consumed with hunger in the land, nor bear the shame of the Gentiles anymore (34:26,27,29)

God calls for the grain and multiplies it, and brings no famine upon me. And He multiplies the fruit of my trees and the increase of my fields, so that I need never again bear the reproach of famine among the nations (36:29,30)

The Lord God is my inheritance, and He is my possession (44:28)

Daniel

God brings me into the favor and goodwill of those above me (1:9)

I tell dreams and their interpretation and I receive gifts, rewards, and great honor (2:6)

I am compared to a tree which grows strong, whose height reaches to the heavens and which can be seen by all the earth, whose leaves are lovely and its fruit abundant, in which is food for all, under which the beasts of the field dwell, and in whose branches the birds of the heaven have their home (4:20-22)

Hosea

God is like the dew to me; I shall grow like the lily, and lengthen my roots like Lebanon. My branches shall spread; my beauty shall be like an olive tree, and my fragrance like Lebanon (14:5,6)

Joel

The Lord sends me grain and new wine and oil, and I am satisfied by them; I am not a reproach among the nations (2:19)

I am glad and rejoice in the Lord my God; for He has given me the former rain faithfully, and He causes the rain to come down for me – the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month. The threshing floors are full of wheat, and the vats overflow with new wine and oil. God restores to me the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the crawling locust, the

consuming locust, and the chewing locust. I eat in plenty and am satisfied, and praise the Name of the Lord my God. My people shall never be put to shame (2:23-26)

I drip with new wine, and overflow with milk; I am flooded with water and a fountain flows from me the house of the Lord (3:18)

Obadiah

On Mount Zion I have deliverance and holiness; I possess my possessions (17)

Habakkuk

Though the fig tree may not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines; though the labor of the olive may fail, and the fields yield no food; though the flock may be cut off from the fold, and there be no herd in the stalls – yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation (3:17,18)

Haggai

I sow much and bring in much; I eat and have enough; I drink, and am filled with drink; I clothe myself, and am warm; I earn wages to put them into a bag without holes (1:6)

The silver and gold belong to God and me because I am His son (2:8)

Even from this day, the Lord continues to bless me (2:19)

Zechariah

I spread out through prosperity; the Lord comforts me, and has chosen me (1:17)

My seed is prosperous, the vine gives its fruit, the ground gives her increase, and the heavens give their dew – the Lord causes me to possess all these (8:12)

The Lord is determined to do good to me (8:15)

I am a prisoner of hope. Even today God declares that He will restore double to me (9:12)

Malachi

I do not rob God in tithes and offering, therefore I am blessed. I bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in God's house. I have tried Him in that, and He opens for me the windows of heaven and pours out for me such blessing that there is no room enough to receive it. And the devourer is rebuked so that He does not destroy the fruit of my ground, nor does the vine fail to bear fruit for me in the field. All nations call me blessed, for I am a delightful land (3:8-12)

To me who fears God's Name the Sun of Righteousness has arisen with healing in His wings; I go out and grow fat like the stall-fed calves (4:2)

The Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John)

I rejoice I the highly favored one, the Lord is with me; I am blessed (Lk1:28)

I have favor with God (Lk1:30)

He who is mighty has done great things for me. He has filled me with good things, and the rich He has sent away empty (Lk1:49,53)

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward me (Lk2:14)

The grace of God is upon me (Lk2:40)

I am increasing in favor with God and men (Lk2:52)

I lay up for myself treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where my treasure is, there my heart will be also (Mt6:20)

I cannot serve God and mammon. Therefore I do not worry about my life, what I will eat or what I will drink; nor about my body, what I will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? The birds of the air neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet my heavenly Father feeds them. I am of more value than they. I will not worry about clothing. The lilies of the field neither toil nor spin; yet even Solomon in all His glory was not arrayed like one of these. Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe me? Therefore I do not worry, saying, "What shall I eat, what shall I drink, what shall I wear?" For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For my heavenly Father knows that I need all these things. But I seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things are added to me. Therefore I do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble (Mt6:24-26,28-34)

My heavenly Father gives me good things when I ask Him (Mt7:11)

Whatever I want men to do to me, I do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets (Mt7:12)

I give to everyone who asks of me (Lk6:30)

Just as I want men to do to me, I also do to them (Lk6:31)

I love my enemies, I do good and lend, hoping for nothing in return; my reward is great, and I am a son of the Most High; for He is kind to the unthankful and evil. Therefore I am merciful, just as my Father also is merciful (Lk6:35, 36)

I give, and it is given to me: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over is put into my bosom. For with the same measure that I use, it is measured back to me (Lk6:38)

I receive the rewards of prophets and righteous men because I receive them (Mt10:41)

Of Jesus' fullness I have received, and grace for grace. For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ (Jn1:16, 17)

I have left houses, brothers, sisters, father, mother, wife, children and lands, for Jesus' sake and the gospel's. Therefore I receive a hundredfold now in this time with persecutions and in the age to come eternal life (Mt19:29; Mk10:29, 30)

I tithe of my possessions, without passing by justice, and the love of God (Lk11:42)

I am not covetous, for my life does not consist in the abundance of the things I possess (Lk12:15)

I do not worry about my life, what I will eat; nor about the body, what I will put on. Life is more than food, and the body is more than clothing. The ravens neither sow nor reap, they have neither storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them. I am of much more value than the birds. The lilies neither toil nor spin; and yet even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. If God so clothes the grass, which today is in the field and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, He will clothe me much more. I do not seek what I should eat or what I should drink nor have an anxious mind. For all these things the nations of the world seek after, and my Father knows that I need these things. But I seek the kingdom of God, and all these things are added to me. I do not fear, for it is my Father's good pleasure to give me the kingdom. I sell what I have and give alms; I provide myself money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor does moth destroy. For where my treasure is, there my heart also will be (Lk12:22-24,27-34)

I am always with my Father, and all that He has is mine (Lk15:31)

I am faithful in the unrighteous mammon; true riches are committed to my trust. I cannot serve God and mammon (Lk16:11,13)

I give more than everybody else; for they all give out of their abundance to God, but I give all that I have, my whole livelihood (Mk12:43,44; Lk21:3,4)

I tithe of everything without neglecting the weightier matters – justice and mercy and faith (Mt23:23)

I am a good and faithful servant; I am faithful over a few things, God makes me ruler over many things (Mt25:21)

I give food to the hungry, I give drink to the thirsty, and I take in strangers and clothe the naked (Mt25:35,36)

The Acts of the Apostles

I have favor with all people (2:47)

Great grace is upon me (4:33)

I do not lack any good thing (4:34)

God gives me favor in the presence of kings (7:10)

I have found favor before God (7:46)

I give alms generously always and pray to God always. My prayers and my alms come up for a memorial before God (10:2,4)

I am commended to God and to the Word of God's grace which builds me up and gives me an inheritance among all those who are sanctified (20:32)

I support the weak and I am blessed because I am a giver (20:35)

Romans

I reign in life because I receive the abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness (5:17)

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for me freely gives me all good things (8:32)

I give with liberality. I distribute to the needs of the saints, and am given to hospitality (12:8,13)

I render to all their due: taxes to whom taxes are due, customs to whom customs (13:7)

I owe no man anything but to love them, for I who loves another have fulfilled the law (13:8)

I am a partaker of Israel's spiritual things so I minister to them in material things (15:27)

First Corinthians

God reveals to me by His Spirit the things which He has prepared for me who loves Him (2:9, 10)

I labor, working with my hands (4:12)

I sow material things into those who have sowed into me spiritual things (9:11)

Whatever I do, I do all to the glory of God (10:31)

I bestow all my goods to feed the poor and I have love, therefore it profits me (13:3)

Second Corinthians

I abound in the riches of liberality. I give according to and beyond my ability (8:2, 3)

I abound in the grace of giving also (8:7)

I know the grace of my Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for my sake He became poor, that I through His poverty might become rich (8:9)

My abundance supplies the lack of the saints; and their abundance supplies my lack – that there may be equality. As it is written, “He who gathered much had nothing left over, and he who gathered little had no lack” (8:14,15)

I have zeal to give (9:2)

I sow bountifully and I reap bountifully (9:6)

I give as I purpose in my heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver (9:7)

God makes all grace abound toward me, that I, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. As it is written: “He has dispersed abroad, he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever.” God, who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supplies and multiplies the seed I have sown and increases the fruit of my righteousness, while I am enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through me to God. For the administration of this service not only supplies the needs of the saints, but also is abounding through many thanksgivings to God (9:8-12)

I am a burden to no one and in everything I keep myself from being burdensome to anybody (11:9)

I lay up wealth for my children; they do not lay up for me (12:14)

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ is with me (13:14)

Galatians

In me all the nations shall be blessed for I am blessed with believing Abraham (3:8,9)

Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law having become a curse for me; the blessing of Abraham is on me in Christ Jesus and I have received (3:13,14)

I share in all good things with those that teach me (6:6)

I sow to the Spirit, and therefore I reap the life of God in everything. And I do not get weary while doing good, for in due season I shall reap if I do not lose heart. Therefore, as I have opportunity, I do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith (6:8-10)

The grace of my Lord Jesus Christ is with my spirit (6:18)

Ephesians

God has blessed me with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ (1:3)

In Jesus I have obtained an inheritance (1:11)

I am God's own handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, born anew that I may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for me - taking paths which He prepared ahead of time - that I should walk in them, living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for me to live (2:10 AMPC)

I labor working with my hands what is good that I may have something to give to him who has need (4:28)

Philippians

I am anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, my requests have been made known to God; the peace of God which surpasses all understanding guards my heart and mind through Christ Jesus (4:6,7)

I rejoice in the Lord greatly that people's care for me flourishes (4:10)

I have learnt in whatever state I am, to be content: I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (4:11-13)

Because of my giving, God supplies all my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus (4:19)

Colossians

Whatever I do in word or deed, I do all in the Name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (3:17)

I obey my masters in all things, in sincerity of heart, fearing God; whatever I do, I do it heartily as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord I will receive the reward of the inheritance for I serve the Lord Christ (3:22 - 24)

I give people what is just and fair, knowing that I also have a Master in heaven (4:1)

First Thessalonians

I labor and toil, that I might not be a burden to any one (2:9)

I aspire to lead a quiet life, to mind my own business and to work with my hands, as I have been commanded, that I may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that I may lack nothing (4:11,12)

Second Thessalonians

I do not eat anyone's bread free of charge, but I work with labor and toil night and day, that I might not be a burden to any one (3:8)

First Timothy

I exercise myself toward godliness. For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come (4:7, 8)

I repay my parents; for this is good and acceptable before God (5:4)

I provide for my own especially those of my household (5:8)

The elders who rule well I count worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in the word and doctrine. For I shall not muzzle an ox while it treads out the grain and the laborer is worthy of his wages (5:17,18)

Having food and clothing, with these I am content (6:8)

I am rich yet not haughty, nor do I trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives me richly all things to enjoy. I do good, so I am rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, storing up for myself a good foundation for the time to come, that I may lay hold on eternal life (6:17-19)

Second Timothy

I am strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus (2:1)

Titus

I learn to maintain good works, to meet urgent needs that I may not be unfruitful (3:14)

Philemon

The sharing of my faith is effective by the acknowledgement of every good thing which is in me in Christ Jesus (6)

I refresh the hearts of the saints (7)

Hebrews

The Lord is mindful of me, He takes care of me; He has crowned me with glory and honor, set me over the works of His hands and in Christ put all things in subjection under my feet (2:6-8)

I come boldly to the throne of grace that I may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need (4:16)

God is not unjust to forget my work and labor of love which I have shown toward His Name in that I have ministered to the saints and do minister (6:10)

Surely God blesses and multiplies me (6:14)

Jesus who forever lives receives my tithes in heaven (7:8)

I have a better and enduring possession for myself in heaven (10:34)

I believe that God is and He rewards me as I diligently seek Him (11:6)

I choose rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin. I esteem the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in the world for I am looking to the reward (11:25,26)

My conduct is without covetousness; I am content with such things as I have. For God will never leave me nor forsake me and He is my helper (13:5,6)

I do not forget to do good and share, for with these sacrifices God is well pleased (13:16)

James

Even though I am rich I glory in my humility (1:10)

Every good gift and every perfect gift in my life is from above and comes down from my Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning (1:17,18)

I am a doer of the Word, and not a hearer only, deceiving myself; I am blessed in what I do (1:22,25)

I ask of God and receive because I ask right, not to spend on my pleasures (4:3)

God gives me more grace. He resists the proud but gives me grace because I am humble (4:6)

My workers receive their full wages (5:4)

First Peter

I inherit a blessing. I love life and love to see good days; therefore I refrain my tongue from evil and my lips from speaking deceit; I turn away from evil and do good; I seek peace and pursue it (3:9-11)

I am submissive to my spiritual elders and am clothed with humility, for God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble. Therefore I humble myself under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt me in due time (5:5,6)

Second Peter

Grace and peace are multiplied to me in the knowledge of God and Jesus my Lord, as His divine power has given to me all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called me by glory and virtue (1:2,3)

I am growing in the grace and knowledge of my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (3:18)

First John

This is the confidence that I have in God, that if I ask anything according to His will, He hears me. And if I know that He hears me, whatever I ask, I know that I have the petitions that I have asked of Him (5:14, 15)

I buy of Jesus gold refined in fire, that I may be rich (3:18)
