My delight is in the Word of the Lord and in His Word I meditate day and night; I am like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in season, whose leaf shall not wither; whatever I do prospers (1:2,3)

When angry I do not sin. I meditate within my heart on my bed, and I am still (4:4)

The Lord leads me in His righteousness and makes my way straight before my face (5:8)

The Words of the Lord are pure Words, like silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times (12:6)

I have good understanding and so gain favor (13:15)

I am a prudent man who acts with knowledge (13:16)

Poverty and shame will not come to me because I do not disdain instruction; I regard a rebuke and so I am honored (13:18)

I walk with the wise and become wise (13:20)

I am wise; my crown is my riches (14:24)

I have great understanding, therefore I am slow to wrath (14:29)

Jesus' favor is toward me a wise servant (14:35)

I am righteous, my heart studies how to answer (15:28)

The Lord directs my steps (16:9)

I spare my words because I have knowledge; I am of a calm spirit because I am a man of understanding (17:27)

My stomach is satisfied from the fruit of my mouth; by the produce of my lips I shall be filled (18:20)

Life is in the power of my tongue (18:21)

My discretion makes me slow to anger, and my glory is to overlook a transgression (19:11)

Counsel in my heart is deep water, and I a man of understanding draws it out (20:5)

I am the righteous man who walks in integrity, my children are blessed after me (20:7)

I have wisdom, it gives me life (7:12)

Wisdom strengthens me the wise more than ten rulers of the city (7:19)

Because I please God, I escape from the woman whose heart is snares and nets and whose hands are fetters (7:26)

My wisdom makes my face shine and the sternness of my face is changed (8:1)

I am wise, my heart discerns both time and judgment because for every matter there is time and judgment (8:5,6)

My words are gracious, because I am wise (10:12)

Isaiah

I am willing and obedient, so I eat the good of the land (1:19)

God teaches me His ways and I walk in His paths (2:3)

The Spirit of the Lord rests upon me, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord. My delight is in the fear of the Lord, I do not judge by the sight of eyes, nor decide by the hearing of my ears; but with righteousness I judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth (11:1-4)

The Lord is my God, I exalt Him; I praise His Name for He has done wonderful things, His counsels of old are faithful and truth (25:1)

The Lord keeps me in perfect peace because my mind is stayed on Him and I trust in Him (26:3)

The desire of my soul is for the Name of the Lord, and for the remembrance of Him. With my soul I desire Him in the night, yes, by my spirit within me I seek Him early (26:8-9)

I believe in Jesus so I do not act hastily (28:16)

The Lord is a God of justice; I am blessed because I wait for Him (30:18)

My eyes are not dim, and my ears listen; my heart understands knowledge and my tongue speaks plainly (32:3,4)

Wisdom and knowledge are the stability of my times, and the strength of salvation (33:6)

I walk righteously and speak uprightly, I despise the gain of oppressions and refuse bribes, and I stop my ear from the hearing of bloodshed and shut my eyes from seeing evil. Therefore I dwell on high, my place of defense is the fortress of rocks; bread is given to me and my water is sure and my eyes see the King in His beauty (33:15-17)

My hands are strengthened and my knees are made firm; I am strong and I do not fear for my God has come to save me; my eyes are opened and the ears unstopped; I leap like a deer and my tongue sings (35:3,6)

I walk on the Highway of Holiness where I cannot go astray; on it there is no lion nor any ravenous beast (35:8,9)

I walk before the Lord in truth and with a loyal heart, and do good in His sight (38:3)

The grass withers, the flower fades, but the Word of my God stands forever (40:8)

I renew my strength, I mount up with wings like eagles, I run but not get weary and I walk but not faint because I wait on the Lord (40:31)

The Lord has called me in righteousness and holds my hands (42:6)

Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things God declares; before they spring forth He tells me of them (42:9)

I fear not for God has redeemed me; He has called me by my name; I am His. When I pass through the waters, He is with me; and through the rivers, they do not overflow me. When I walk through the fire, I am not burned, nor does the flame scorch me. For the Lord is my God, the Holy One of Israel, my Savior (43:1-3)

God holds my right hand to subdue nations before me and loose the armor of kings, to open before me the double doors, so that the gates will not be shut: He goes before me and makes the crooked places straight; He breaks in pieces the gates of bronze and cuts the bars of iron (45:1,2)

The Lord raises me up in righteousness, and directs all my ways (45:13)

God has upheld me from birth, and carried me from the womb: Even to my old age God is He, and even to gray hairs He will carry me. He has made me, and He will bear; He will carry, and will deliver me (46:3,4)

God's counsel for me stands and He does in and for me all His pleasure. He has purposed it, He will also do it (46:10,11)

The Lord makes me hear new things from this time, even hidden things that I did not know (48:6)

The Lord my God teaches me to profit, and leads me by the way I should go. I heed His commandments, therefore my peace is like a river and my righteousness like the waves of the sea (48:17,18)

I feed along the roads, and my pastures are on all the desolate heights. I shall neither hunger nor thirst, neither heat nor sun shall strike me; for He who has mercy on me leads me, even by the springs of water and He guides me (49:9,10)

A woman can forget her nursing child, and not have compassion on the son of her womb; yet the Lord will not forget me. He has inscribed me on the palms of His hands; my walls are continually before Him (49:15,16)

I know that God is the Lord and I shall not be ashamed I who waits for Him (49:23)

The Lord has given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him who is weary. He awakens me morning by morning, He awakens my ear to hear as the learned; He has opened my ear and I am not rebellious (50:4,5)

I follow after righteousness and I seek the Lord; I look to the rock from which I was hewn, and to the hole of the pit from which I was dug. I look to Abraham my father, and to Sarah: For God called him alone, and blessed him and increased him (51:1,2)

I listen to God and I am not fearful of the reproach of men, nor am I afraid of their insults (51:7)

God has put His Words in my mouth and covered me with the shadow of His hand (51:16)

I do not go out in haste, nor go by flight; for the Lord goes before me, and the God of Israel is my rear guard (52:12)

I am God's servant, I deal prudently (52:13)

I listen carefully to God, and eat what is good, and my soul delights itself in abundance (55:2)

God's thoughts have become my thoughts, and His ways have become my ways (55:8)

As the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so is God's Word that goes forth from His mouth; it shall not return to Him void, but it shall accomplish what He pleases, and it shall prosper in the thing for which He sent it (55:10,11)

My fasting loosens the bonds of wickedness, undoes the heavy burdens, lets the oppressed go free, and breaks every yoke. I share my bread with the hungry and bring to my house the poor who are cast out; when I see the naked I cover him, and I do not hide myself from my own flesh. Therefore my light breaks forth like the morning, and my healing springs forth speedily; my righteousness goes before me and the glory of the Lord is my rear guard; when I call the Lord answers me, when I cry He says, "Here I am." I take away the yoke from my midst, the pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, I extend my soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul. Therefore my light dawns in the darkness, and my darkness is as the noonday. The Lord guides me continually (58:6-11)

I delight myself in the Lord and He causes me to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feeds me with the heritage of Jacob (58:14)

I arise and shine for my light has come and the glory of the Lord is risen upon me. For darkness covers the earth, and deep darkness the people, but the Lord arises over me and His glory is seen upon me. The sun is no longer my light by day; nor for the brightness does the moon give light to me; but the Lord is to me an everlasting light and my God my glory. My sun never goes down, nor does my moon withdraw itself; for the Lord is my everlasting light (60:1,2,19,20)

As a beast goes down into the valley, and the Spirit of the Lord causes him to rest, so the Lord leads me to make Himself a glorious name (63:14)

Since the beginning of the world men have not heard nor perceived by the ear, nor has the eye seen any God besides God, who acts for me who waits for Him. God meets me who rejoices and does righteousness, who remembers Him in my ways (64:4,5)

Before I call, God answers; and while I am still speaking He hears (65:24)

The Lord looks on me because I am poor and of a contrite spirit, and I tremble at His Word (66:2)

Jeremiah

I go to all to whom God sends me, and whatever He commands me I speak (1:7)

God remembers the kindness of my youth and the love of my betrothal, when I went after Him in the wilderness, in a land not sown (2:2)

Just like a virgin cannot forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire, so can I not forget my God (2:32)

God gives me shepherds according to His heart who feed me with knowledge and understanding (3:15)

I walk in the good way of the Lord; therefore I find rest for my soul (6:16)

My God has made the earth by His power, He has established the world by His wisdom, and stretched out the heavens at His discretion (10:12)

God's Word is to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart; for I am called by His Name (15:16)

God visits me and performs His good Word toward me. For He knows the thoughts He thinks toward me, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give me a future and a hope. I call upon Him, I pray to Him, and He listens to me. I seek Him and find Him for I search for Him with all my heart (29:10-13)

This is the covenant that God made with me: He put His law in my mind, and wrote it on my heart; He is my God and I am His. No more shall anyone teach me saying, "Know the Lord," for I know Him. For He has forgiven my iniquity and my sin He remembers no more (31:33,34)

God is great in counsel and mighty in work for His eyes are open to all ways of the sons of men, to give everyone according to his ways and according to the fruit of his doings (32:19)

I call to God and He answers me and shows me great and mighty things which I do not know (33:3)

The Lord my God shows me the way in which I should walk and the thing I should do (42:3)

God has made the earth by His power; He has established the world by His wisdom, and stretched out the heaven by His understanding (51:15)

Lamentations

The Lord is good to me who waits for Him, to me who seeks Him (3:25)

Ezekiel

I eat the Word of God and it is in my mouth like honey in sweetness (3:3)

I receive into my heart all God's Words that He speaks to me, and I hear with my ears (3:10)

God has given me one heart, and put a new spirit within me; He has taken the stony heart out of my flesh and given me a heart of flesh that I may walk in His statutes and keep His judgments and do them (11:19,20)

The Lord is God. He speaks and that which He speaks comes to pass; it is no more postponed for in my days God says the Word and performs it (12:25)

None of God's Word will be postponed any more, but the Words which He speaks will be done (12:28)

God has given me a new heart and put a new spirit within me; He has taken the heart of stone out of my flesh and given me a heart of flesh. He has put His Spirit within me and causes me to walk in His statutes, and I keep His judgments and do them (36:26,27)

Daniel

I am gifted in all wisdom, possessing knowledge and I am quick to understand, and I have the ability to serve in kings' palaces (1:4)

God gives me knowledge and skill in all literature and wisdom; I have understanding in all visions and dreams (1:17)

In all matters of wisdom and understanding about which I am examined, I am found ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers (1:20)

I always answer with counsel and wisdom (2:14)

God reveals secrets to me in night visions (2:19)

Blessed be the Name of God forever and ever, for wisdom and might are His. He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives me wisdom and understanding. He reveals to me deep and secret things; He knows what is in the darkness, and light dwells with Him. I thank and praise Him; He has given me wisdom and might, and makes known to me what I ask of Him (2:20-23)

My God is a revealer of secrets (2:47)

Because the Spirit of the Holy God is in me, no secret troubles me and I explain visions and dreams and their interpretations (4:9)

The Spirit of the Holy God is in me, therefore understanding and wisdom are found in me. I have an excellent spirit, knowledge and understanding. I have the gift of interpretation of dreams, solving riddles, and explaining enigmas (5:11,12)

The Spirit of God is in me, light and understanding and excellent wisdom are found in me (5:14)

I am distinguished above my contemporaries because an excellent spirit is in me (6:3)

Angels come to me from heaven, because I am greatly beloved of God (9:23)

I the wise shine like the brightness of the firmament; and I who turns many to righteousness shines like the stars forever and ever (12:3)

Hosea

God loves me and calls me, His son, out of Egypt; He teaches me to walk taking me by my arms; He draws me with gentle cords, with bands of love (11:1,3,4)

I wait on my God continually (12:6)

The ways of the Lord are right; I the righteous walk in them, but the transgressors stumble in them (14:9)

Joel

God has poured His Spirit on us; my children, my wife and I prophesy, we dream dreams, and we see visions (2:28)

Amos

Surely the Lord God does nothing, unless He reveals His secret to me His servant the prophet (3:7)

Micah

God teaches me His ways and I walk in His paths (4:2)

The Lord has shown me what is good; He requires of me to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly before Him (6:8)

When I sit in darkness, the Lord will be a light to me; He will bring me forth to the light, and I will see His righteousness (7:8,9)

Habakkuk

I write God's vision to me and I make it plain on tablets that I may read and run with it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time; but at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, I wait for it; because it will surely come, and it will not tarry (2:2,3)

I am being filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea (2:14)

The Lord God is my strength; He makes my feet like the deer's feet, and He makes me walk on my high hills (3:19)

Haggai

According to the Word that God covenanted with me when I came out of Egypt, so His Spirit remains with me; I do not fear (2:5)

Zechariah

I am called the City of Truth (8:3)

Malachi

God's covenant is with me, one of life and peace, and He gave it to me that I might fear Him; so I fear Him and am reverent before His Name. The law of truth is in my mouth, and injustice is not found on my lips. I walk with God in peace and equity, and turn many from iniquity. For my lips keep knowledge, and people seek the law from my mouth; for I am a messenger of the Lord of hosts (2:5-7)

The Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John)

Jesus the Word is life and that life is my light (Jn1:4)

Gabriel who stands in the presence of God is sent to speak to me and brings me glad tidings (Lk1:19)

My feet are guided into the way of peace (Lk1:79)

God divinely warns me in dreams (Mt2:12)

Jesus is the true Light which gives me light in the world (Jn1:9)

God gives His angels charge over me, to keep me. In their hands they bear me up lest I dash my foot against a stone (Mt4:6; Lk4:10,11)

Angels come and minister to me (Mt4:11)

I, who sat in darkness, have seen a great Light, and upon me, who sat in the region and shadow of death, light has dawned (Mt4:16)

I am following Jesus (Mt4:19; Mk1:16)

I have entered by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it (Mt7:13,14)

I am aware of false prophets, who come to me in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. I will know them by their fruits (Mt7:15,16)

I hear the sayings of Jesus and do them. I am like a wise man who built his house on the rock; and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock (Mt7:24,25)

I forsake all and follow Jesus (Lk5:11)

I continue all night in prayer to God (Lk6:12)

I do not look at the speck in my brother's eye, but do not perceive the plank in my own eye. I first remove the plank from my own eye, and then I see clearly to remove the speck that is in my brother's eye (Lk6:41,42)

I come to Jesus, and hear His sayings and do them. I am like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the rock (Lk6:47,48)

I hear the Word and do the will of My Father in heaven (Mt12:50; Mk3:35; Lk8:21)

It has been given to me to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven. I take heed what and how I hear. With the measure I use, it is measured to me; to me who hears, more is given. I have, and more is being given to me (Mt13:11,12; Mk4:11,24,25; Lk8:10,18)

Hearing I hear and understand; seeing I see and perceive. For my heart is not dull, my ears are not hard of hearing, and my eyes are open. Blessed are my eyes for they see and my ears for they hear (Mt13:14-16)

I hear the Word and understand it, and indeed bear fruit and produce a hundredfold in the good ground of my heart (Mt13:23; Mk4:20)

Having heard the Word with a noble and good heart, I keep it and bear fruit with patience (Lk8:15)

I am instructed concerning the kingdom of heaven, I am like a householder who brings out of his treasure things new and old (Mt13:52)

I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden things from the wise and prudent and have revealed them to me. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight (Mt11:25,26)

I daily take up my cross and follow Jesus (Mt10:38)

I can of myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and my judgment is righteous, because I do not seek my own will but the will of the Father who sent me (Jn5:30)

I discern the signs of the times (Mt16:3)

Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. Flesh and blood has not revealed this to me, but my Father who is in heaven (Mt16:16,17; Mk8:29; Lk9:20; Jn6:69)

I deny myself, and take up my cross, and follow Jesus. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for Jesus and the gospel's sake will find it (Mt16:24,25; Mk8:34,35; Lk9:23,24)

It is the Spirit who gives me life; the flesh profits nothing. The Words Jesus speaks to me are spirit, and they are life (Jn6:63)

The Holy Spirit teaches me every hour what I ought to say (Lk12:12)

Like Jesus, I do not judge according to appearance, but I judge with righteous judgment (Jn7:24)

Jesus is the light of the world. I who follows Him shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life (Jn8:12)

I abide in the Word of Jesus, I am His disciple indeed. I know the truth and the truth makes me free (Jn8:31,32)

I am of God so I hear His Words (Jn8:47)

I keep Jesus' Words; I shall never see death (Jn8:51)

Jesus is my good Shepherd; I know Him and He knows me (Jn10:14)

I am Jesus' sheep and I hear His voice, and He knows me, and I follow Him (Jn10:27)

Jesus gives me a mouth and wisdom which all my adversaries are not able to contradict or resist (Lk21:15)

I serve Jesus, so I follow Him; and where He is, there am I His servant, and the Father honors me (Jn12:26)

Whatever I speak, just as the Father has told me, so I speak (Jn12:50)

Jesus is my Way to the Father; He is my Truth and my Life (Jn14:6)

I love Jesus, so I keep His commandments (Jn14:15)

The Father has given me another Helper to abide with me forever – the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him, nor knows Him; but I know Him, for He dwells with me and He is in me (Jn14:15-17)

I who has Jesus' commandments and keeps them, it is me who loves Him. And I who loves Him is loved by the Father, and Jesus loves me and manifests Himself to me (Jn14:21)

I love Jesus and so keep His Word; and His Father loves me, and They come to me and make Their home with me (Jn14:23)

The Helper, the Holy Spirit whom the Father sent in Jesus' Name, teaches me all things, and brings to my remembrance all things that Jesus said to me (Jn14:26)

As the Father loved Jesus, He also has loved me; I abide in His love. I keep His commandments and abide in His love, just as He kept the Father's commandments and abode in His love (Jn15:9,10)

I am Jesus' friend because I do whatever He commands me (Jn15:14)

The Spirit of truth guides me into all truth and tells me things to come. He glorifies Jesus, for He takes of what is Jesus' and declares it to me (Jn16:13,14)

I watch and pray; therefore I do not enter into temptation (Mt26:41; Mk14:38; Lk22:46)

Beginning at Moses and all the prophets, Jesus expounds to me in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself (Lk24:27)

Jesus opens my understanding and I comprehend the Scriptures (Lk24:45)

The Acts of the Apostles

I prophesy, I dream dreams and see visions (2:17)

The Lord is always before my face; He is at my right hand that I may not be shaken (2:25)

I listen more to God than to men (4:19)

I am full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom (6:3)

I give myself continually to prayer and the Word (6:4)

The world is not able to resist the wisdom and Spirit by which I speak (6:10)

I build God's house exactly according to the pattern He shows me (7:44)

The Spirit of the Lord catches me away (8:39)

I see visions (9:12)

God shows me many things I must suffer for His Name's sake (9:16)

I see clearly in a vision an angel of God coming and speaking to me (10:3)

I am a man after God's own heart and will do all that He wills (13:22)

I serve my generation by the will of God (13:36)

I am more fair-minded than others in that I readily receive the Word of God and search the Scriptures to confirm it (17:11)

In God I live and move and have my being (17:28)

I am commended to God and to the Word of God's grace which builds me up and gives me an inheritance among all those who are sanctified (20:32)

I am chosen by God to know His will, and see the Just One and hear the voice of His mouth, for I am His witness to all men (22:14)

Romans

I was buried with Jesus through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so I also should walk in the newness of life (6:4)

I delight in the law of God according to the inward man (7:22)

I do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. God condemned sin in the

flesh, that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in me who does not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit (8:1-4)

I set my mind on the things of the Spirit (8:5)

I am a son of God, so I am led by the Spirit (8:14)

The Spirit helps in my weaknesses. For I do not know what to pray for as I ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for me with groanings which cannot be uttered. Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for me according to the will of God (8:26,27)

I have zeal for God according to knowledge (10:2)

My faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God (10:17)

I do not conform to this world, but I am transformed by the renewing of my mind, that I may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God (12:2)

I am not wise in my own opinion (12:16)

I am subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God (13:1)

My salvation is nearer than when I first believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore I cast off the works of darkness, and I put on the armor of light. I walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. But I put on the Lord Jesus and make no provision for the flesh to fulfill its lusts (13:11-14)

I am wise in what is good and simple concerning evil, and my God of peace crashes satan under my feet (16:19,20)

First Corinthians

Of God I am in Christ Jesus who became for me wisdom from God (1:30)

God reveals to me by His Spirit the things which He has prepared for me who loves Him (2:9,10)

I have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that I may know the things that have been freely given to me by God. These things I also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual (2:12,13)

I have the mind of Christ (2:16)

I judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts (4:5)

All things are lawful for me, but all things are not helpful. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any (6:12)

I speak with the tongues of men and of angels. And I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge (13:1,2)

Speaking in tongues, I am speaking not to men but to God, for no one understands me; however in the Spirit I speak mysteries (14:2)

When I speak in a tongue I also interpret (14:13)

I pray with the spirit, and I also pray with the understanding. I sing with the spirit, and I also sing with the understanding (14:15)

I am not a child in understanding; however in malice I am a babe, but in understanding I am mature (14:20)

Second Corinthians

My boasting is this: the testimony of my conscience that I conduct myself in the world in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom but by the grace of God (1:12)

Satan cannot take advantage of me for I am not ignorant of his devices (2:11)

I have renounced the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the Word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth commending myself to every man's conscience in the sight of God (4:2)

God has shined in my heart to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ (4:6)

I do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal (4:18)

I walk by faith, not by sight (5:7)

The love of Christ compels me (5:14)

I regard no one according to the flesh (5:16)

I abound in knowledge (8:7)

Though I walk in the flesh, I do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of my warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ (10:3-6)

I receive visions and revelations of the Lord. I get caught up in the third heaven (12:1,2)

Galatians

I walk in the Spirit and so I do not fulfill the lusts of the flesh (5:16)

I live in the Spirit, so I walk in the Spirit (5:25)

Ephesians

The God of my Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, gives me the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of my understanding are being enlightened that I may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in me, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward me who believes (1:17-19)

I am alive together with Christ Jesus. I no longer walk according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air. I no longer fulfill the desires of the flesh and of the mind (2:1-3)

I am God's own handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, born anew that I may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for me - taking paths which He prepared ahead of time - that I should walk in them, living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for me to live (2:10 AMPC)

God makes known to me the mysteries of His Kingdom (3:3)

God grants me to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in my heart through faith; that I, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height – and to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that I may be filled with the fullness of God (3:16-19)

I walk worthy of the calling of God with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with others in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (4:1-3)

I no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness (4:17-19)

I put off concerning my former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lust, and I am being renewed in the spirit of my mind, and I put on the new man which was created according to God in true righteousness and holiness (4:22-24)

I imitate God; I walk in love as Christ has also loved me by giving Himself for me, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma (5:1,2)

I walk as a child of light in all goodness, righteousness and truth; I have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness (5:8,11)

I walk circumspectly, not as a fool but as wise, redeeming the time because the days are evil (5:15)

I understand what the will of God is (5:17)

I am being filled with the Spirit, speaking to others in psalms, hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in my heart to the Lord, giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the Name of my Lord Jesus Christ, submitting to others in the fear of God (5:18-21)

I am obedient to my masters with fear and trembling in sincerity of heart as to Christ; I know that whatever good I do, I will receive the same from the Lord (6:5,8)

I am strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. I put on the whole armor of God that I may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. I stand therefore, having girded my waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness and having shod my feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all taking the shield of faith with which I am able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. I take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God; praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints (6:10-18)

Utterance is given to me that I open my mouth boldly to make known the mysteries of the gospel (6:19)

Philippians

My love abounds still more and more in knowledge and all discernment; therefore I approve the things that are excellent (1:9,10)

I do nothing through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind I esteem others better than myself. I look out not only for my interests, but also the interests of others. This mind is in me which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross (2:3-8)

I do not set my mind on earthly things. For my citizenship is in heaven, from which I also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ (3:19,20)

The peace of God which surpasses all understanding guards my heart and mind through Christ Jesus (4:7)

I only meditate on things which are true, noble, just, pure, and lovely, of good report, of virtue and that are praiseworthy (4:8)

Colossians

I am filled with the knowledge of God's will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; I walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God (1:9,10)

I am attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge (2:2,3)

I am in the spirit, rejoicing to see good (2:5)

I walk in Christ (2:6)

Since I was raised with Christ, I seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. I set my mind on things above, not on things on the earth (3:1,2)

The peace of God rules in my heart, to which I was called in one body; and I am thankful (3:15)

The Word of Christ dwells in me richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing others in psalms, hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in my heart to the Lord (3:16)

I obey my masters in all things, in sincerity of heart, fearing God (3:22)

I continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving (4:2)

I walk with wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time. My speech is always with grace, seasoned with salt, that I may know how I ought to answer each one (4:5,6)

Like Epaphras, I always labor fervently for the saints and myself that we may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God (4:12)

First Thessalonians

The Word of God effectively works in me who believes (2:13)

I am taught by God to love others; and indeed I do so toward all the brethren, and I increase more and more (4:9,10)

I aspire to lead a quiet life, to mind my own business and to work with my hands, as I have been commanded, that I may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that I may lack nothing (4:11,12)

I am not in darkness, so that this Day should overtake me as a thief. I am a son of light and son of the day. I am not of the night nor of darkness. Therefore I do not sleep, as others do, but I watch and I am sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation (5:4-6,8)

I rejoice always and pray without ceasing; in everything I give thanks for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for me. I do not quench the Spirit. I do not despise prophecies. I test all things and hold fast what is good (5:16-21)

Second Thessalonians

The Lord directs my heart into the love of God and into the patience of Christ (3:5)

First Timothy

My love is from a pure heart, from a good conscience and from sincere faith (1:5)

According to the prophecies previously made concerning me, by them I wage the good warfare, having faith and a good conscience (1:18,19)

I guard what was committed to my trust, avoiding the profane and idle babblings and contradictions of what is falsely called knowledge (6:20)

Second Timothy

I serve God with a pure conscience (1:3)

God has not given me a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind (1:6,7)

I hold fast the pattern of sound words which I have heard, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus (1:13)

The Holy Scriptures make me wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus (3:15)

I am watchful in all things, I endure afflictions, and I fulfill my ministry (4:5)

Titus

I am obedient to my masters and well pleasing in all things, not answering back, not pilfering, but showing all good fidelity and I adorn the doctrine of God my Savior. For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to me, teaching me that denying ungodliness and worldly lusts I should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and appearing of my great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for me, that He might redeem me from every lawless deed and purify His own special me, zealous for good works (2:9-14)

I am subject to rulers and authorities, to obey and be ready for every good work (3:1)

Hebrews

God speaks to me by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds (1:2)

Angels are ministering spirits sent forth to minister for me who will inherit salvation (1:14)

I give earnest heed to the things I have heard lest I drift away (2:1)

I believe and so I enter His rest (4:3)

The Word of God is life and power to me, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of my soul and spirit, and of my joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of my heart (4:12)

Solid food belongs to me who is full of age, who by reason of use have my senses exercised to discern both good and evil (5:14)

I daily taste the good Word of God and the powers of the age to come (6:5)

I do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises (6:12)

I do all things according to the pattern God shows me (8:5)

This is the covenant that God has made with me: He has put His laws in my mind and written them on my heart; He is my God and I am His. No one teaches me saying, "Know the Lord," for I know Him. For He has been merciful to my unrighteousness, and my sins and my lawless deeds He will remember no more (8:10-12)

This is the covenant God has made with me: He has put His laws into my heart, and in my mind He has written them; my sins and lawless deeds He remembers no more (10:16,17)

I choose rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin. I esteem the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in the world for I am looking to the reward (11:25,26)

I endure all things because I see Him who is invisible (11:27)

Since I am surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, I lay aside every weight and the sin which so easily ensnares and I run with endurance the race that is set before me, looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of my faith who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. I consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest I become weary and discouraged in my soul (12:1-3)

I do not despise the chastening of the Lord, nor am I discouraged when He rebukes me. For who the Lord loves He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives (12:5,6)

The Lord chastens me for my profit, that I may be a partaker of His holiness (12:10)

I pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which I will not see the Lord: looking carefully lest any root of bitterness springing up causes trouble (12:14,15)

I entertain strangers, for by so doing I have unwittingly entertained angels (13:2)

I remember those who rule over me, who have spoken the Word of God to me, whose faith I follow, considering the outcome of their conduct (13:7)

I am not carried about with various and strange doctrines. For my heart is established by grace (13:9)

I obey those who rule over me and I am submissive, for they watch out for my soul, as those who must give account (13:17)

I am confident that I have a good conscience, in all things desiring to live honorably (13:18)

The God of peace who brought up my Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, makes me complete in every good work to do His will, working in me what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever (13:20,21)

James

I am swift to hear, slow to speak and slow to wrath (1:19)

I am a doer of the Word, and not a hearer only, deceiving myself (1:22)

I do not stumble in word, I am a perfect man, able also to bridle my whole body (3:2)

I am wise and understanding; I show by good conduct that my works are done in the meekness of wisdom (3:13)

My wisdom that is from above is pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy (3:17)

First Peter

I submit myself to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake (2:13)

I am submissive to my masters with all fear, not only to the good and gentle, but also to the harsh. For this is commendable, if because of conscience toward God I endure grief, suffering wrongfully (2:18,19)

The end of all things is at hand; therefore I am serious and watchful in my prayers (4:7)

I am submissive to my spiritual elders and I am clothed with humility, for God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble. Therefore I humble myself under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt me in due time (5:5,6)

I am sober and vigilant; because my adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour (5:8)

Second Peter

I have the prophetic Word confirmed, which I heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in my heart (1:19)

My conduct is holy and godly, looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God. According to His promise, I look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. Therefore, looking forward to these things, I am diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless (3:11-14)

First John

I walk in the light as God is in the light (1:7)

I have an anointing from the Holy One and I know all things. The anointing I received from the Father abides in me, and I do not need that anyone teach me; but as the same anointing teaches me concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught me, I will abide in Him. I abide in Him, that when He appears, I may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming (2:20,27,28)

I do not believe every spirit, but I test every spirit, whether they are of God. By this I know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God, and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God (4:1-3)

I am of God. He who knows God hears me; he who is not of God does not hear me. By this I know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error (4:6)

God's commandments are not burdensome to me (5:3)

I know that the Son of God has come and has given me an understanding, that I may know Him who is true (5:20)

Second John

God rejoices greatly that I walk in truth, as I have received commandment from Him (4)

Third John

God has no greater joy than to know that I walk in truth, and for sure I walk in truth (4)

The Revelation of Jesus Christ

I read and hear the words of the prophecy in the Book of Revelation, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near (1:3)

Jesus gives me some of the hidden manna to eat and a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except I who receives it (2:17)

I go up to heaven and God shows me things to come (4:1)

I follow the Lamb wherever He goes (14:4)

My Jesus is coming quickly! Blessed am I who keeps the words of the prophecy of the book of revelation (22:7)

Blessed am I who does His commandments, I have the right to the tree of life, and I enter through the gates into the city (22:14)
